Wearable Art is for Everyone!

- Invent, plan, design and cut - stitch, sew or sculpt.
- Paint, stick, weave, or weld, knit, bind or bolt.
- Fabric, cardboard, leather, wool - plastic, flax or foam.
- Fibre, beads, glass or clay - metal, shells or bone.

All entries must contain visible and obvious tartan.
This can be painted, engineered, stitched or woven.

Be cool, be bold, be different - anything goes. Let your fancy take flight and create your own unique, completely, madly, wonderful piece of wearable art.

Conditions and Criteria for Entry

- Wearable Art must be **original**.
- Entries must be wearable and must be art.
- You may submit more than one entry.
- Each Entry must be on a separate Entry Form.
- **Wearable Art** shown previously in Northland or the Far North is not eligible for entry, but Wearable Art shown elsewhere previously may be entered and eligible for the competition; Wearable Art which has been awarded a prize in any other competition cannot be entered in the Art N Tartan competition.
- Any entrant may enter the OPEN category, but the First Time category is only for those who have not entered Art N Tartan before. Entries in the 'open' category and the First Time category must be for Adult sized creations.
- Entries in the Student category may be adult or child sized.
- **Tartan** is defined as a pattern consisting of criss-crossed horizontal bands in multiple colours, which is repeated in all directions, resulting in a distinctive pattern of squares and lines known as a sett. It can be painted, knitted, engineered, stitched, woven – limited only by your imagination!!
- **Judging:** Art N Tartan will be judged by a panel of three judges who will act independently of the Art N Tartan Team, who play no part in the judging process. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- **Models:** Local designers usually choose their own models. Models need to have an understanding of the expression and essence of the wearable art they are showing.

They also need to have stage personality and be confident to express themselves to the music at rehearsals and the shows.

- **Models:** Where designers from outside the local area require a model, please contact the Art N Tartan team to discuss your size requirements prior to commencing your artwork.
- **Models:** Must be available to attend the preliminary judging day, all rehearsals and all three shows. Wearable means an entry must be able to be worn continuously for up to an hour, and must be able to move freely on the runway. Models must be able to see, breathe easily, and walk up and down steps or ramps.
- **Entries** may be created using any materials, either new or recycled, except plant materials which may deteriorate.
- **After Preliminary Judging** entries may not be changed in any way.
- Art N Tartan reserves the right to refuse any entry considered unsuitable.
- Art N Tartan reserves the right to edit information you supply with your entry, and to use your entry for display purposes after the show.
- **Entry fees** are nonrefundable, except where an entry is not accepted.
- Art N Tartan does not accept liability for entries lost or damaged in transit. Entrants are responsible for insurance and packaging, and for all return freight costs if required.
- Entries will be used [where available] for exhibition later in the year.
- **Professional Images** will be taken of each entry for the show programme, posting on Art N Tartan Facebook, Instagram, and the Waipu Museum website.
